



## SOCIAL WORKERS IN SCHOOLS

Social workers are now based in nine secondary schools across Cumbria. Solway Community School and Beacon Hill School are taking part in the project. The aim of the project is to provide on site support/advice for teachers, young people and their families. In turn, this will reduce the number of referrals to statutory social work. Social workers will work with teachers, children and their families in school to provide a range of support and advice. They will undertake direct work with children and families who are in need of support.

Drop-in sessions will be available on a weekly basis. If you have any concerns or just require advice/support, you can call into school. The sessions can also signpost you to other services that would best meet your needs.
