The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection.
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can.
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs.
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19.
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement.
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, text, email and the school website.

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 14 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible.
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately.
- If dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- My child **will not** bring any items into school with them or take items home from school **other than packed lunch and drinks.**
- My child will have their temperature taken during the day if they feel or present as being unwell.
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules including on the way to and from school, and I will ensure that my children and family as a whole adhere to strict social distancing at all times and understand that if alleged breaches are reported to school they will pass on concerns to the relevant authorities and this could lead to my child being unable to attend school
- My child will use good respiratory and hand hygiene.
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email.
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during this crisis.
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home.
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details.
- If my child is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.
- I agree to the approach set out in the Cumbria Futures Federation Charter.

I will:

Keep my distance from other students and people in school

Tell an adult immediately if I feel unwell

Follow instructions promptly and follow the behaviour policy, including specific Covid-19 behaviour policies

Only use equipment provided by the school, and leave it in school

Adhere to strict social distancing when on the way to and from school, during breaks and lunchtimes as well as within the school building

Adhere to strict social distancing at all times when not in school – if alleged breaches are reported, this will be reported to the relevant authorities and this could lead to me being unable to attend school
